**WHEN:** EVERY SATURDAY FROM APRIL 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Each farm or group is permitted to occupy a single site. Only officially marked sites may be used. Site size will be 15'X25' as marked by the Town. No assigned spaces or reservations allowed.

All produce/products available for sale in the market are restricted to those products actually grown in North Carolina. This includes but not limited to the following items (or within the spirit of) Apples, Beans, Corn, Cabbage, Homemade Preserves, Honey, Lettuce, Okra, Peaches, Pumpkins, Squash, Strawberries, and Tomatoes.

Items not allowed for sale in the market include live animals, processed animals, manufactured or commercially produced goods, craft goods, second hand or used items, items purchased for resale, junk, and other non edible items. No out of state produce or products are allowed under any circumstances.

All Department of Agriculture regulations apply within the market.

All products will be fresh and sold under sanitary conditions. Each vendor will provide their own handy wipes for sanitary purposes and will thoroughly wash hands prior to handling produce. For more information go to [www.ncagr.com](http://www.ncagr.com)

The seller is responsible for leaving their site clean and in good order at the end of the day. Failure to comply will result in expulsion and or probation of the seller for 1 year. Repeat offenders may be barred for 10 years as decided upon by the officials.

Products should be clearly marked and marketed in accordance with current market rate or similar quality.

All produce sellers are required to display a 2008 Grower's Certificate. These certificates may be obtained from the County Agricultural agent at no cost. This certification is required by North Carolina State law so that sales tax does not have to be collected by the grower.
