

Chapter 3

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES*

Sec. 3-101. Public consumption.

No person shall consume, serve or drink wine, beer, whiskey or alcoholic beverages of any kind on the public streets, boulevards, alleys or on public property.

Sec. 3-102. Hours regulated.

It shall be unlawful for any person to sell any malt beverage or wine (fortified or unfortified) between the hours of 1:00 a.m. on Sunday until 7:00 a.m. on the following Monday within the town. Each separate sale during the aforesaid hours shall constitute a separate offense.
